Georgiana Rael, Kim Leach, Isaac Cisneros, David Smith, Chad Mantz and Ron Burnham were present.


**3. MEMORIAL DAY SITUATIONAL ANALYSIS DISCUSSION**

Marshal Smith discussed the law enforcement situation update. The Banititos will probably take a low profile since the Waco incident; we will probably see local chapters this year but not see a lot of numbers. Always the main focus is DWI and violent crimes. The police will be seven fewer on staff than last year. The Auslander and Edweiss donated rooms this year. Volunteers are needed for serving food.

Ron Burnham went over the projected resource availability and demand dashboard and the expected demand and projected capacity with comments of the Town of Red River and the Enchanted Circle. Last year the total calls were 15 and 7 of those were transfers. Ron went over the Complexity Analysis for risk assessment and if the event exceeds day to day routines and capacity and safety.
