**PUBLIC WORKS UPDATE**

They have been working on W. River Street. Made 3 new taps to get everyone on the new main and abandon the old 2" line. Were not able to locate the old line at Main St so they cut and capped halfway to Main. They feel there is a leak somewhere along the old line but will have to wait until next summer to find and cap off at Main St.

We had some discussion about getting prepared to replace old 8" line along Main St if and when the State funds the sidewalk replacement.

All the sidewalks have been repaired and the handy cap fishing areas along the river restoration have been poured.

The crew is preparing to put up Christmas lights in the park.

They are hoping to clean the AWWT river discharge in the next week or two when they can get an excavator scheduled. The plant is preparing on RBC basins to hold the flow while the work is being done.

They are also working with the engineers on the water asset inventory which is part of the Asset Mgmt Plan. This needs to be completed by next August and is a requirement for future grant applications.

**RECYCLING UPDATE**

They are looking at possibly taking the products to Eagle Nest rather than Taos. Would be shorter travel and save money. They are also looking at an option to have a recycler from Taos to come and pick up items, but have not heard back from him.

**ALLEY AND TREE BY SUNDANCE**

John and Linda Hoag have asked the town to cut down the tree in the alley just east of the building. Albert made a motion that the town negotiate to move the alley to between where Sundance parks on both sides. Now the parking is on the alley and driving is on the Hoags property. Richard seconded and all were in favor. Apparently there had been negotiations to move the alley next to Erik's Workshop, however Hoags built their home at that location.

## **OTHER**

Jake asked if we could put steel T Posts and orange fencing along the snow making pond so someone does not drive into the lake. Isaac said he would look into it.

Russell reported that the manhole rehabilitation is complete. They had 46 to work on and all but 3 or 4 were completed. Those need to be raise since they were below grade. The contractor noted that we have a grease problem in the collection

Russell reported that the 2 monitoring wells at AWWT have been drilled and developed. Staff will need to be trained on how to sample from the wells.

Russell reported that the reclamation project is finished and the sidewalk and handicap fishing piers have been completed.
