From Albuquerque to Red River:

Catch Rail Runner to Santa Fe at 7:20 am

No Layover in Santa Fe

RTD (Blue Bus) will be waiting at the Santa Fe train station which will bring **YOU** into Española

You will be changing buses at Ohkay Owingeh Casino South lot, transfer on to Taos bus it will be waiting.

Española bus will be dropping you off at the Taos Court house at approximately 11:30 am you will transfer on to the Questa bus at 5:00 p.m. (5 hour layover) You can go online and find the Chile Line Schedule and be able to travel around Taos during layover.

Questa bus will drop you off at the Chevron station where you will transfer on to the Red River bus

And you're on your way to RED RIVER which takes 15 to 20 minutes.

In Red River we offer the Miners Transit which will take you anywhere around the Red River area **(575)**

Going to Albuquerque from Red River:

Only 6:20am bus will take you to Albuquerque from Red River

Be at the Red River Conference Center at 6:20 am

(There is no waiting time when you reach Chevron (Questa) you can board the Taos bus immediately after arriving)

You will arrive at the Taos Courthouse where you will have a 45 minute layover.

Transfer on to Española bus which takes you into Ohkay Owingeh Casino (south)

45min layover

Santa Fe bus takes you into South Capital Station (Santa Fe) arrives at 11:20

2 ½ hour layover for the Rail Runner which you board onto Albuquerque

Will take you to Alvarado Transportation Center where you can board Albuquerque Transit (web-site for schedule)
