PUBLIC WORKS UPDATE:

They replaced 10' of the 14" line. The bottom of the old ductile was worn thin with holes. While turning the water off for this repair, a leak surfaced on Main Street in front of go-cart track. They repaired a 2" hole in that 8" line. Isaac feels the leak in the 14" was one of our largest. Since the repair they have been able cut off wells 5 and 6.

They repaired a valve seal gasket at Mallette and High.

There is another valve that needs repair at Caribel and Main, which they plan to repair soon. There have another leak at Caribel and River St., so they plan to move three taps to the new 6" line and abandon the old 2" line.

RECYCLING UPDATE:

That has slowed down quite a bit. They just moved a load of cardboard and need to take a load of mixed paper soon.

CLAIM JUMPER STREET UPDATE:

That project has been postponed until next July. We did not get all the funding yet and the ski area deadline to have the pond full again is October 1st.

RIVER RESTORATION UPDATE:

On September 12 the contractor was give notice to proceed. They plan to start construction on September 26th. In the next week rock and other material will be brought in. The contractor hopes to complete the work in 3 weeks.

OTHER:

Jumping Jack Trail was been repaved and is back in service after a couple weeks of rain delay.

There was a request from David Taylor to extend irrigation meter reading into September. Georgiana commented that the ordinance allows June, July and August. However, the ordinance is being updated in the near future, so council can take the request into consideration.
