Public Works Update:

The crew finished installing the Fire Hydrant at Auslander. They had a specialty contractor install a shutoff valve for the hydrant, live without having to shut down the 14" main.

The crew is still preparing for Memorial Day. 1. Have finished Roding sewer lines. 2. Getting signs ready, trying to paint curbs and no parking areas, but need to rent a sprayer, ours is not working anymore.

Recycling Update:

They plan to move bins behind town hall for Memorial Day and the Encampment week. Issac is still looking for a place to move it permanently since we do not want to fence off the parking lot. There was discussion about having it at the treatment facility, but someone would probably need to be there on weekends and there is a question about how many people would actually drive out there. There was discussion about the possibility that plastic may soon no longer be accepted. There was discussion about the new grant bins. The small bins are side load and can only be emptied in the trash truck, and the roll off is a different dimension than ours and does not fit our truck without modifications. We discussed returning them to the state. The members asked Issac to try to come up with the cost of running the recycle operation to see what it actually costs us. Some members feel the money could be better use on other infrastructure needs.

PER Update:

Russell told the committee that the State has accepted our Preliminary Engineering Report for the water system.
